Bespoke plan for returning expeditioners

We have six Africamps planned for the summer of 2008 and due to this increase in numbers we have decided to design a set program for returning Africampers. Below is an itinerary and prices for each of the separate sections that people are welcome to apply for. This allows people to choose their preferred section on a pay-by-item basis.

This will give you the opportunity to return to Kenya with a little more flexibility; essentially you are planning your own trip while still under the care of Adventure Alternative and our Kenyan company Africampers.

Please note that if you choose not to go on a particular section and spend time instead travelling in Kenya by yourself then you will not be under the care of Adventure Alternative and we cannot be held responsible for your safety and welfare.

ITINERARY & PRICES FOR BESPOKE AFRICAMP

1st – 6th July Black Cats Training/Nairobi projects Price - £200
6 days staying in NPS campsite, accompanied by AA staff; the program includes visiting the Animal orphanage, Giraffe centre, Sheldrick Elephant Foundation, MM projects and the slums of Nairobi. There will be a couple of days training and playing with our Black Cats Football Team or exploring deeper in to the slums to visit and experience the realities of life in the poorest areas of Nairobi and seeing how our family support programme works.

7th – 17th July Embu Africamp Project Price - £350
Join the Africamp team at the Scout Centre in Embu to work on the Africamp project and street children camp

18th – 21st July Safari Price - £250
Three day safari, based at the BlueLine Hotel in Naro Moru, the 18th July will be a travel day to Naro Moru from Embu, day one on the safari (19th July) will be at Sweetwaters Game Reserve, day two will be horse riding on the slopes of Mt Kenya, visiting the Mau Mau Caves and day three at Solio Ranch (if weather permits) which is Kenya's main

Rhino sanctuary. If the weather is not suitable (4x4's are required when it has been raining) then we could return to Sweetwaters or visit the Aberdares National Park.

**22nd - 27th July Mt Kenya or Embu Rescue Centre Mt Kenya Price - £350
Rescue Centre Price - £200**

Two options available for these dates; either spend 6 days on the mountain with the Embu Africamp Team or alternatively you can spend six days working with the street kids at the Rescue Centre and County Primary in Embu.

28th July - 7th August Ulamba Orphanage in Siaya Price - £250

Travel to Western Kenya on the 28th July to arrive at the orphanage in the early evening, spend 9 full days with the kids at the orphanage. School should finish on Friday 1st August so it will give you a unique opportunity to spend quality time with the children, Mama Rose and the Ulamba team. There is so much to get involved with and Maurice has started his own Black Cats team with kids from Ulamba & Kayeiyie School.

8th - 17th August Nairobi Africamp Project Price - £350

Meet up with the Nairobi Africamp team on the 8th August to work on a community project in Kibera and a street kid camp at Rowallan Scout Centre.

**18th - 25th August Kilimanjaro or Nanyuki Rescue Centre Kili Price - £850
Rescue Centre Price - £250**

Climb Africa's highest peak at an incredibly discounted price or spend a week at the Nanyuki Street Children's Home; this is a children's home that Moving Mountains is looking at supporting so you would be some of the first people to visit on our behalf. The Home is terribly under-funded, expect a very challenging and rewarding week.

26th August - 2nd September Jambo Jipya, Mtwapa Price - £350

Take the overnight bus to Mombasa on the evening of the 25th August to arrive at Jamboree Campsite on Bamburi Beach on the morning of the 26th August. Spend the week mixing some R & R with working at the Jambo Jipya School and Orphanage. You will have the chance to visit the homes of some of the kids we support and help Christine with the day to day running of the orphanage. Travel back to Nairobi on the overnight bus/train.

3rd September – onward travel/flight home/teaching

If you would like to extend your stay in Kenya then we have opportunities to teach in selected schools in Nairobi, Embu & Siaya District. The cost is £600 per month which is the minimum length of time that you can teach for; ideally we would prefer you to spend 3 months as this is the length of a Kenyan school term.

The prices above include the following;

- Accommodation (mainly in tents)
- UK & Kenyan Administration/Organisation/Staff (always accompanied)
- All food prepared by Africampers staff
- Internal travel/transport
- Donations made to Orphanages/Rescue Centres visited
- Project costs on Africamps
- National Park Fees (where applicable)
- Safari Costs & Camping Equipment
- Activities in Nairobi (Giraffe and Elephant Centre/Animal Orphanage)
- Activities in Mombasa (Snorkelling, Fort Jesus & Camel Riding!)

Not included are international airfares, 3 month holiday Visa, travel insurance, personal spending money & vaccinations/malaria tablets

To book a place please fill in an online Africamp application form and mention in the comments box that this is a Bespoke Africamp trip. You can then email us seperately detailing your choices and we will prepare an invoice by return. A deposit of £250 through our online payment system will secure your place and all final payments must be made six weeks prior to departure.

You will need to organise your own flights and we have an account with STA Travel who can provide your travel arrangements if you wish. Later you can email us your flight plans so we can arrange the airport pick-ups.
